- **Thursday, September 14th *Wine Train: Fenn Valley Vineyard Tour.*** Todd Robbins, Head Viticulturist at Fenn Valley and LHBM Board Member, will personally lead this tour. You will see how the grapes are grown and the kinds of operations that are performed that result in award winning wines. The samplings are fabulous and the vistas breathtaking. Enjoy appetizers at 4:30 before a 5:30 departure. \$25 per person and this includes a picnic dinner afterwards.
- **Sunday, October 8th** We are thrilled to bring the documentary: *Look & See: A Portrait of Wendell Berry* to South Haven! In this film you will see the world through the works of farmer, writer and activist Wendell Berry. It reflects the values expressed throughout all of Berry's work: membership in community, service, land-stewardship, honest accounting, sustainable economies, and a "small is beautiful" worldview. This exclusive screening will be at the First Congregational Church in South Haven at 3 P.M. Jeffrey Dick will be leading a book talk at the museum later this fall based on Berry's latest title, *Our Only World: Ten Essays*. Books will be available to purchase at the museum.
- **Saturday, October 14th *Worm Composting/Create Your Own Complete Composting Bin .*** Taught by a vermicompost pro from Crop Services International. You will learn how to create top-quality vermicompost and brew which turns into high-quality compost and compost tea for your garden and houseplants.
